
## What is Complete Streets and why do we need this policy?

Complete Streets is a term describing roads that allow safe and convenient travel for everyone who uses them and for all modes of transportation. These streets have crosswalks, accessible sidewalks, and bicycle lanes that make it easy to walk to the store, bike to work, or cross the street to and from a bus stop. Complete streets policies require that every future road construction and reconstruction project makes a street safe and comfortable for all users—kids, families, older adults, or people with disabilities—whether they are walking, pushing a stroller, using a wheelchair, riding a bike, driving a car, or taking public transportation. While we have had a Complete Streets policy, it needed updating for best practices.

If you had any doubt that Complete Streets is a fair and affordable housing issue, look at the map below of crashes involving pedestrians or bicyclists. I was stunned at the how much this is an issue of livability in

lower income places. Of course Complete Streets is for everyone and for that reason alone should be updated to improve safety in Louisville.

This has just been passed by the Planning Commission and will be going to Council. Please ask your Council Member to support this updating of the Complete Streets policy. If you want to see MHC's written remarks to the Planning Commission, just ask **Cathy** or **Tony**.
